### **Regular but infrequent services**

Excursions usually ran from South Wales via this route to The Royal Welsh Show held in late July at Builth. The Show was cancelled in 2001, because of the foot & mouth epidemic but resumed in subsequent years.

**Whitakers Jn - Balm Road loop and Darmouth Jn - Dartmouth branch [*Middleton Railway*]** [63]

On the Saturday and Sunday of the Autumn Steam & Diesel Gala, usually held on the last weekend in September, trains usually used these sections.

**Bishops Lydeard - Norton Fitzwarren (WSR boundary) [*West Somerset Railway*]** [8]

On one or more days of "special event" weekends trains used this section. In 2002 trains used this section of Friday 22 March (only) of Spring Steam Gala weekend. From 10 March 2002 an unadvertised 1330 Bishops Lydeard - Norton Fitzwarren and back ran on service "A" days (*except* about one day a month - as announced locally - when the "diesel" service was loco hauled and this train did not run).

**Aylesbury - Quainton Road** [35]

On Bank Holiday Mondays (apart from Christmas) and the Sunday of Buckinghamshire Railway Centre's Annual Autumn Steam-Up (2001 date: 7 October), a chartered shuttle service of trains used this section.
