Unless otherwise indicated, trains operated Sunday 28 September 2003 to Saturday 22 May 2004. Details incorporate both the partial timetable re-issue by Network Rail from 4 January 2004 and Iarnród Éireann's timetable re-issue from 14 December 2003. All dates quoted are inclusive, but services and timings may be altered on public holidays.

Even though the first phase of the Channel Tunnel Rail Link - which opened for regular public service from 28 September 2003 - does not feature on the National Rail Timetable Map 2003-2004, it was included in tables 350-352 and is not therefore regarded as a candidate for inclusion in **PSUL**.
