Unless otherwise indicated, trains operated *Monday 27 September to Saturday 11 December 2004*. All dates quoted are inclusive, but services and timings may be altered on public holidays. This foreshortened period marked the transition from a timetable year with timetables issued in May and September, to one where the principal change became December, with a subsidiary change the following May, and also where the normal start date for each timetable was altered from a Monday to a Sunday.
