**The following sections of preserved railways over which no regular public services operate. While known to have been used occasionally by publicly available services, no consistent or regular public use could be ascertained during 2018:**

Moor Road (Leeds) station - Balm Road loop [*Middleton Railway*]: the railway is authorised to operate passenger trains over this line on a limited number of occasions each year. On two weekends in recent seasons trains have used this section, some trains being freight trains carrying passengers.

Barrow Hill Roundhouse Railway Centre - connection with Network Rail [*Barrow Hill Engine Shed Society*]

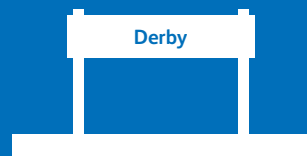

## Why we're doing this

Derby Resignalling is a £200million investment to improve the railway in and around Derby station. It is the biggest investment and improvement programme at Derby for decades and will provide better journeys for thousands of passengers every year.

Although the station itself was modernised in 2013, the current track layout has not been improved for nearly 50 years and the signalling has not been comprehensively upgraded since the 1960s. During this time, the number of passengers travelling through Derby has more than doubled.

The investment will provide:

- A new platform
- Upgraded track and signalling
- New track layout to remove the current bottlenecks which force trains to wait for a platform outside Derby station
