Unless otherwise indicated, trains operated from Sunday 15 December 2019 until Saturday 12 December 2020. However, the substantive changes introduced on 17 May continued to be subject to alteration or suspension on account of Covid-19 coronavirus. All dates quoted were inclusive, but services and timings were subject to further and short notice alteration at any time - particularly over the Christmas/New Year period and on public holidays. Some unusual 'unsocial hours' routeings may be to allow for engineering possessions on a more direct route - to which trains may revert if there is no engineering work.

At the start of the timetable period, of the services shown below some Northern services were subject to cancellations (particularly at weekends) on account of staff rostering difficulties, while many TransPennine Express Liverpool - Newcastle - Edinburgh and vice versa services were cancelled pending completion of crew training on new rolling stock; subsequently TPE services - particularly on that route - were extensively recast from what is shown in the Network Rail May 2020 public and working timetables (from which the details given below were derived) and made available only on a basis which makes it virtually impossible to show here their booked service reliably for record purposes.

COVID-19 - coronavirus

From 18 March 2020 operators began reducing services and from 23 March 2020 all operators had significantly reduced their services (some more than once), so most of the entries below were not then running to the timings or frequency shown. Information is given below affected entries in **green type** as follows:

- Where it is known that *at least one* (possibly more) of the booked trains

continued to use the line in question.

- Where it is known that *all* services over a line had been suspended.
- Where it is known that *at least one* (possibly more) of the booked trains has resumed use of the line in question.
- Where no resumption date is given, all services remained suspended as at 28 August 2020.

It was impractical to capture all the detailed changes. Services shown with operating dates subsequent to 16 May 2020 - including those without end date - represent the planned summer/autumn service. However, services continued to be subject to alteration or suspension on account of Covid-19 coronavirus, until a general return to 'normal' services was implemented in early/mid September - some TOCs from 7 September, others from 14 September. Services which had been restored from or by week commencing 14 September 2020 are denoted below by note ‡ (where multiple times are shown in an entry, ‡ follows the relevant time(s) instead of at the end of the line); services not so marked appear not to have resumed by the end of the timetable year. Further service reductions were implemented from mid-November until early December 2020 but no attempt has been made to track such changes. Scotland, Wales, Ireland and Northern Ireland may have implemented service reductions and resumptions at different dates.
