The 2021 timetable year was scheduled to operate from Sunday 13 December 2020 until Saturday 11 December 2021, with an intermediate change date of Sunday 16 May 2021 from when services would be subject to the summer and autumn timetable variations to carry the service through until December. However, the public eNRT timetable which should have started on 13 December 2020 was "cancelled" and this announcement appeared on Network Rail's eNRT webpage:

December 2020 NRT - update

The December 2020 NRT has been cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic's impact on the volume of change on the operational timetable. This level of change means we cannot produce an NRT that represents a high standard of accuracy and therefore would not benefit our customers.

While 'base line' working timetables from 13 December 2020 were published, they continued to be subject to such extensive alterations as train operators reacted to Covid-19 effects that it was impracticable to compile **PSUL** for that first half of the timetable year.

Unless otherwise indicated, the service details given below applied from Sunday 16 May 2021 until Saturday 11 December 2021.

All dates quoted are inclusive, but services and timings were subject to further and short notice alteration at any time - particularly over public holidays. Services were particularly subject to short-term changes on account of Covid-19 coronavirus during the period late July to mid-September.

Some unusual 'unsocial hours' routings were to allow for engineering possessions on a more direct route - to which trains may have reverted if there was no engineering work.

The following sections of preserved railways over which no regular public services operate are known to have been used occasionally by publicly available services. Moor Road (Leeds) station - Balm Road loop [[Middleton Railway](#)]: the railway is authorised to operate passenger trains over this line on a limited number of occasions each year. On two weekends in recent seasons trains have used this section, some trains being freight trains carrying passengers.

Barrow Hill Roundhouse Railway Centre - connection with Network Rail; Roundhouse platform - Springwell [[Barrow Hill Engine Shed Society](#)]: the Springwell service usually operates on event days

Swithland Sidings - Nunckley Hill Platform [- Mountsorrel] [[Mountsorrel & Rothley Community Heritage Centre](#)]: as advertised on their and Great Central Railway websites. From autumn 2019 services have normally been restricted to the Swithland Sidings - Nunckley Hill Platform section, with no workings to Mountsorrel. No service in 2021 because of damage to trap points at Swithland.

Swanwick Junction - end of line at Greenhill [[Midland Railway Trust](#)]

Tyseley Locomotive Works internal trackage [[Tyseley Locomotive Works](#)]: on works open weekends.

Norchard Low Level - Middle Forge Junction ground frame [[Dean Forest Railway](#)]: may be used on special events days - particularly on those when separate services are advertised: Norchard (high level) - Parkend and Norchard (low level) - Lydney Junction (although on *Thomas* days the low level platform is used only for Thomas + brake van shunts). Santa services between Norchard and Parkend usually operate from and to low level platform with reversal at Middle Forge Junction. Most regular trains at Norchard use the high level platform on the through line.

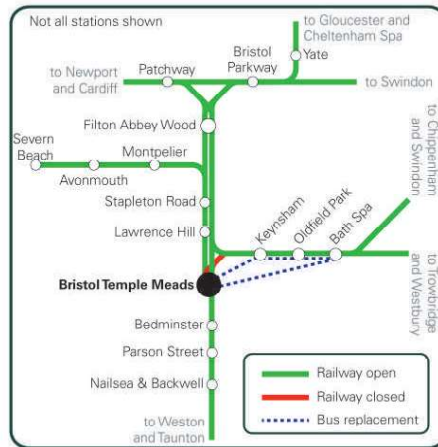

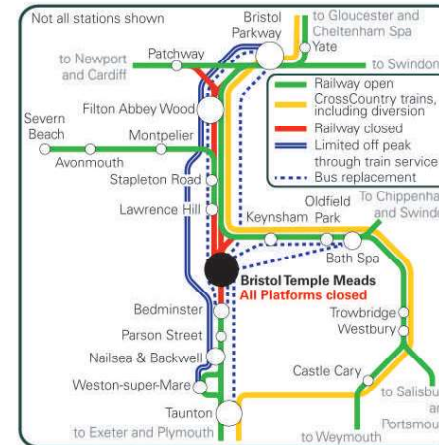

- Buses replace all trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway, Bath Spa and Bedminster (non-stop and calling at all stations)
- Buses replace all trains to Bristol Parkway or Bath Spa (non-stop and calling at all stations)
- Buses also replace CrossCountry trains between Bristol Temple Meads and both Taunton and Bristol Parkway

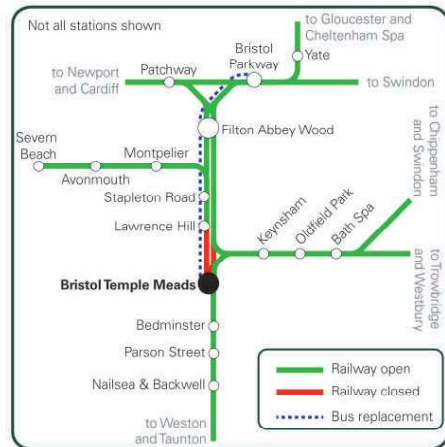
What's happening

Bristol Temple Meads is being transformed and the railway serving the area upgraded – paving the way for more train services to move more people, more reliably. The Bristol Rail Regeneration programme will deliver new tracks and stations in the area, enabling more trains to run on the network to meet growing demand.

This summer Network Rail is improving the track layout on the approach to Bristol Temple Meads, and this will require changes to some train services.

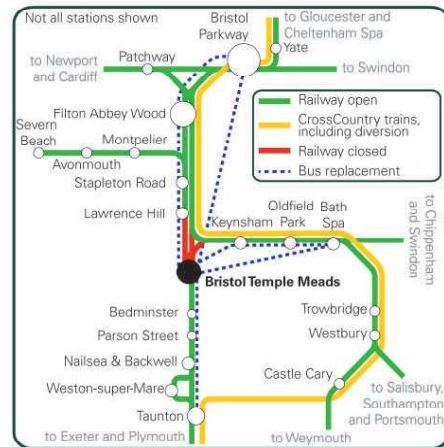
Saturday 10 July to Friday 6 August

- Reduced train service running between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway
- No direct trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central/Gloucester – change at Bristol Parkway instead
- Trains between Filton Abbey Wood and Bath Spa will not call at Bristol Temple Meads
- Trains will run between Severn Beach and Lawrence Hill only (except on Sundays when buses replace trains)
- Buses replace trains from Bristol Temple Meads to Lawrence Hill, Stapleton Road, Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Parkway



Saturday 7 August

- No train service between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway or Bath Spa
- London Paddington and CrossCountry trains will not call at Bristol Temple Meads
- Trains between Filton Abbey Wood and Bath Spa will not call at Bristol Temple Meads
- Trains will run between Severn Beach and Lawrence Hill only
- Buses replace all trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway or Bath Spa (non-stop and calling at all stations)
- Buses also replace CrossCountry trains between Bristol Parkway, Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton



Trains will run between London Paddington and Bath Spa, and London Paddington and South Wales via Bristol Parkway throughout this period.

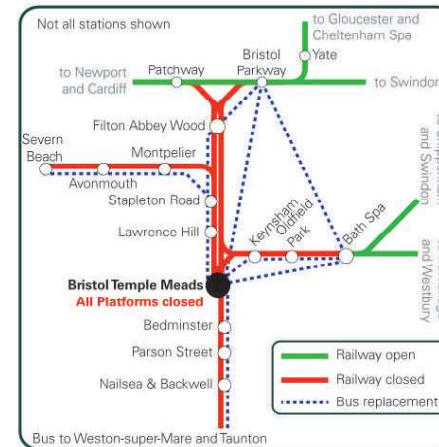
Trains between London Paddington and the South West via Taunton are also unaffected by these upgrades.

Our travel advice

- Plan ahead – train and replacement bus times will be different to normal train times
- Allow plenty of time – journeys involving a replacement bus will take longer than trains
- Adhere to government guidelines – we'll have markers and signs around our stations

Sunday 8 August

- **No train services to/from Bristol Temple Meads**
- Buses replace all trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway, Bath Spa and Weston-super-Mare (non-stop and calling at all stations)
- Buses will also run between Bristol Parkway and Bath Spa (non-stop)
- Buses replace trains to Severn Beach (calling at all stations)
- Buses also replace CrossCountry trains between Bristol Parkway, Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton



Using replacement buses

Space is limited on buses/coaches compared to trains, so please don't bring large items of luggage, bikes (excluding folding bikes), or dogs (excluding assistance dogs). Pushchairs must be folded up and stored as luggage. Buses for Bedminster, Keynsham and Oldfield Park will be a short walk from the station.

- Off-peak trains will run between Weston-super-Mare and Bristol Parkway, but will not call at Bristol Temple Meads
- Trains will run between Severn Beach and Lawrence Hill only
- Buses replace all trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway or Bath Spa
- Buses also replace CrossCountry trains between Bristol Temple Meads and both Taunton and Bristol Parkway
